Designed in partnership with the Australasian College of Legal Medicine, the Medical Negligence microcredential has been designed for those who are impacted by the law and wish to understand the law as it applies to their practices for the benefit of their patients. You will investigate the fundamentals of negligence law - harm, duty of care, breach, and causation - contextualised against the broader social and economic policy goals of Australia's universal healthcare system.

This specialised course is delivered remotely through a mix of interactive online workshops and seminars, and self-paced online resources. Upon successful completion of the course and the assessments, you will receive an official academic transcript and 10 credit points, which could be used to apply for advanced standing in a relevant postgraduate degree, subject to the program entry requirements.
