

Magistrates' Court of Victoria Practice Direction

No. 7 of 2022

Confidential Affidavits / Confidential Bundle Exhibits in Civil Division Matters

The purpose of this Practice Direction is to provide for a practice in relation to the filing of an **Affidavit Marked Confidential** and an Affidavit which includes a **Confidential Bundle of Exhibits in Civil Division matters**.

This Practice Direction applies from 3 October 2022.

- An affidavit marked and asserted to be confidential must not be filed by electronic means except as ordered by the Court.
- 2. Parties/practitioners should contact the relevant court registry for instructions as to an alternative method of filing material described in paragraph 1.
- 3. Upon the filing of an Affidavit which annexes in part a confidential bundle exhibit as defined in Magistrates' Court Civil Proceedings Rules 2020 Rule 43.00 that confidential bundle exhibit **must not be filed by electronic means** except as ordered by the Court.
- 4. Parties/practitioners should contact the relevant court registry for instructions as to an alternative method of filing material described in paragraph 3.
