What is the Train the Trainer Program

The Victorian Bar, through its International Advocacy Training Committee (IATC), has partnered with the Papua New Guinea Centre for Judicial Excellence and the Pacific Justice Sector Programme to deliver a Train the Trainer Program. The program is designed to build capacity within the legal profession of Pacific Nations in the field of advocacy training for court appearances.

Who is undertaking the Program?

Twenty delegates from Papua New Guinea, Vanuatu, Tonga, Solomon Islands and Fiji will be in Melbourne from 29 July to 9 August 2024 for an intensive advocacy training program combined with observations of court advocacy in Victoria and a shadowing and mentoring program with Victorian barristers.
